
Key Stage 1 - Forest Academy Knowledge organiser - Plants and Trees

- identify and name a variety of common flowering plants



Plants require things such as water, warmth, nutrients from soil, light and air (carbon dioxide) to grow. If they do not have one or more of these things, they may stop growing.

Plants can:

- move
- grow
- react to their surroundings (sense)
- absorb nutrients
- reproduce

The life cycle of a plant

Growth

-Shoot grows taller and leaves grow from the stalk.

Growth

-Bud forms.

Growth

-Petals open and seeds forms.

Flower

-Seeds drop to the ground.

Seed

-Needs the right temperature and water to germinate.

Germination

-Absorbs water from the ground until the seed splits.

Growth

-Roots grow down into the soil and shoot grows above the ground.

Common garden plants

- People may grow plants in their gardens and care for them.
- They may grow flowering plants which are beautiful to look at or beans and seeds to grow plants for food.
- When plants are grown for food, this may be called a herb garden or vegetable patch.


Flower Life Cycle

- Deciduous trees lose their leaves in the autumn every year. Their leaves are generally broad, flat and have veins running through them.
- Evergreen trees have green leaves all year round. Their leaves are generally thick, waxy and narrow like needles.
