

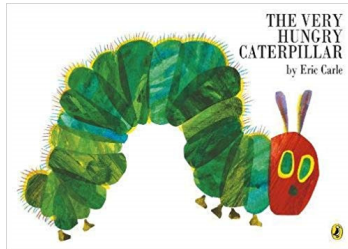

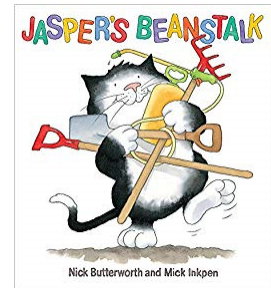

Welcome back, we hope you all had a great half term. Our new topic this half term is 'Glorious Growing'. Our learning will be themed around the stories 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle and 'Jasper's Beanstalk' by Nick Butterworth.



We will be learning both these stories

and drawing story maps to help us retell them. We are going to be welcoming some friends of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, that we will watch as they change, over the next few weeks. We will also be thinking about how to look after plants and help them grow. In our roleplay area we have our very own green grocers where orders can be taken and food can be prepared for customers.

Forest Fridays – (Weather permitting)

Forest schools sessions will begin on Friday 29th February. Children need to wear trousers, long sleeved tops, welly boots and coats. If it is cold, hats and gloves may also be needed. Children can come to nursery in the clothes that they will be wearing but a change of shoes, in a named bag, should be brought with them for after the session.
