
Lower Key Stage 2 World War 2



Session 1 Immersion Day

Children will be immersed in a role play activity designed to recreate the experiences and feelings of an a evacuee in war time Britain.



Children to make 3d model of a human mouth.— including the teeth



Session 7 To generate ideas through discussions and annotated designs.

Children to design own digestive system apron, looking at the placement of organs and using it to teach younger pupils how it works.


Session 10 To identify small items that are precious—link to evacuees.

Children to develop 3d form from 2d sheet using nets.



Session 2 "Why did Britain go to war in 1939?"

To learn the sequence of historical events and use this to consider two sides of an argument



Link to rationing and the different types of food.




Session 8 "Why did Germany lose the Battle of Britain?"

To consider that historical opinions about the Battle of Britain differ.



Session 11 To learn about different means of producing lids for containers and evaluate their effectiveness.



Session 3 "How did the war impact on people back home?"

To analyse sources, putting together a picture of the home front experience (e.g. rationing).

Session 6 To describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system—the intestines.

Children to engage with the practical representation of how the intestines work, make observations.



Session 9 "Why was it necessary to evacuate?"

To answer a historical question, looking at why it was necessary to evacuate people to the countryside.



Session 12 To learn about different means of organising contents in a container e.g. padding, layers, dividers, drawers, and evaluate

their effectiveness.







Session 13 To explore and apply different surface decoration e.g. block printing, peel off/stick on labels, illustrations.

Session 14 To design and make own treasure box, considering the size, how treasures are organised/ protected, how the container is opened and closed, its appearance.

Session 15 To evaluate finished product against design criteria.



Session 16 "Did the war affect Christmas back home?"

To place events in chronological order, examining the changes to Christmas over the course of the

war.
