

Forest Fridays

As it gets colder, hats and gloves may also be needed. Children can come to nursery in the clothes that they will be wearing but a change of shoes should be brought with them for after the session.

This allows children the opportunity to talk about their pets to the rest of the class and share with their friend.

Stay and Play

We will be holding our first 'Stay and Play' session on Thursday 7th November. You are invited to stay with your child and complete a short activity alongside them. You can also join in with your child exploring the nursery activities. The morning session will run 8.40 - 10.00am and the afternoon session will run 12.20 – 1.40pm.

It is important as the colder weather approaches that children have clothing in school suitable for outdoor play. Every child needs a coat in school each day and as it gets colder they can also bring in
