














Key Stage 1—Commotion in the Ocean—Autumn 1st 2020

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Session 1: Science—Germs!

LO: I am learning to describe the importance of hygiene for humans.

Children to look at the germ experiment using glitter. Children will design posters explaining the importance of washing hands.



Session 2: Science Initial Assessment

LO: I am learning to name and identify a variety of common animals.

Children to use small world toys to discuss different animals and their offspring. Year 1 to record interactions through Tapestry, year 2 to complete KWL grid.



Session 3: Science—Deep Sea Diving

LO: I am learning to describe the basic needs of humans for survival.

Children to sort between things they think they need and things that make them happy for a visit to an underwater world.



Session 4: Science – Offspring

LO: I am learning to recognise that animals have offspring.

Children to name different common animals and match the animal to its offspring.



Session 5: Science—Life Cycle of a Turtle

LO: I am learning to recognise that animals have offspring.

Children to observe the life cycle of a turtle. Children to create story maps of the life cycle of a turtle.



Session 6: Science—Pets

LO: I am learning to describe the basic needs of animals.

Children to look at some of the teacher's pets and will ask questions on how to look after them. Children to write list/instructions on how to look after them.



Session 7: Science—How to Look After A Baby?

LO: I am learning to recognise that humans have offspring which grow into adults.

Children to think of some questions for Mrs Baxter/Mrs Eastell on how to look after a baby. Children to role play looking after dollies.



Session 8: Geography - Seven Continents

LO: I am learning to name the seven continents and five oceans.

Children to explore the seven continents by role-playing visiting each continent in the playground. Continents mapped out with stations for children to visit and find out information about each one.



Session 9: Geography—World Map Puzzle

LO: I am learning to use maps and globes to identify the continents and oceans.

Children to use paper maps, globes and atlases to look at continents and oceans. Children to put together a giant world map puzzle, using paper maps as reference.



Session 10: Geography—Plastic in our Oceans

LO: I am learning to name the seven continents and five oceans.

Children to learn about the different oceans in the world. Children to look at the issue of plastic pollution in our oceans. Children to recycle milk bottle caps to create world map.



Session 11: D&T— Making Moving Pictures

LO: I am learning to select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks.

Children to investigate and make pictures with an under the sea theme.



Session 12: D&T— Making Levers Pictures

LO: I am learning to explore and use mechanisms in my product.

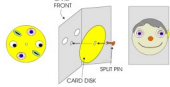
Children to practise making levers for their moving pictures.
