Arctic	Area of frozen sea and land around the South Pole.
Antarctica	Area of frozen sea and land around the North Pole.
climate	Climate is a long-term pattern of the weather conditions.
colour mixing	Mixing colours together to create different colours.
equator	An imaginary circle around the Earth which divides the northern hemi- sphere and southern hemi- sphere.
hemisphere	A hemisphere is formed by dividing the earth into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres at the equator.
North Pole and South Pole	The North and South Poles are opposite ends of the hemisphere.
primary colours	One of the three colours, red, yellow and blue, that can be mixed together in different ways to make any other colour.
secondary colours	A colour resulting from the mixing of two primary colours.
